

WAUBRA WIND FARM SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM



ACCIONA's energy division is a world leader in renewable energy. In Australia, ACCIONA owns and operates the 192MW Waubra Wind Farm and the 132MW Mt Gellibrand Wind Farm in Victoria, the 46.5MW Gunning Wind Farm in New South Wales and jointly owns the 66MW Cathedral Rocks Wind Farm in South Australia with Energy Australia. ACCIONA is currently constructing their fifth wind farm, which is the 157.5 MW Mortlake South Wind Farm in Victoria.

In the area of solar generation, ACCIONA constructed the 20MW Royalla Solar Farm in the ACT for FRV. ACCIONA generally offers sponsorship for the communities in which we have wind farm project interests.

ELIGIBILITY AND PAYMENT CRITERIA

Waubra Wind Farm is located approximately 35 kilometres north-west of Ballarat in Victoria. At peak, the wind farm can generate enough green energy to power more than 138,000 homes or enough electricity for the City of Ballarat and surrounding areas.

ACCIONA and the Waubra Wind Farm are able to provide a one-time scholarship of up to \$5000 for a student wishing to undertake study that will benefit the communities in which they live. Preference will be given to those studying engineering, science or agricultural based courses.

The scholarship program is open to all students from the Pyrenees and City of Ballarat shires, who have recently completed high school, and are wishing to enter into further study at TAFE or University in 2020.

Applications for funding in 2020 close on Friday 27th March 2020.

Selection of the successful candidates will be made according to academic merit, community involvement and with reference to the applicant's response regarding their school activities and responsibilities, future career aspirations, and how your chosen course may benefit the community in the future. A referee is also required for this application. Successful applicants will be required to attend media events as required.

Applicants who are offered an ACCIONA Scholarship will be required to provide proof of enrolment in 2020 and also provide evidence of mid-year pass grades in subjects studied as part of their 2020 tertiary study. The scholarship will be allocated in two instalments. One payment of \$2500 when proof of enrolment is produced and another payment of \$2500 when half yearly results are produced in July 2020. Scholarship funding will be returned to ACCIONA if tertiary studies are ceased or deferred for any reason in 2020.
